THIS MATTER having come before this Court upon the Second Motion of Receiver, Kevin D. Kent, Esquire, for Permission to Initiate Litigation on Behalf of the Receivership Estate;

It is on this 27th day of January, 2022,

ORDERED that the Receiver's Motion for Permission to Initiate Litigation on Behalf of the Receivership Estate at Ecf. No. 98 is APPROVED. The Receiver is authorized, but not required, to commence and prosecute any and all claims against the Proposed Defendants; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Receiver may engage Conrad O'Brien PC on the terms set forth in the Receiver's application for the purpose of initiating litigation against the Proposed Defendants on behalf of the Receivership Estate; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the stay on litigation shall remain intact with regard to all other claims stayed pursuant to the Receivership Order, with the applicable statute of limitations to remain tolled with regard to any cause of action accrued or accruing in favor of one or more of the Receivership Parties against a third person or party for which the injunction against commencement of legal proceedings remains in effect.
